Lower School (PreK-6) - 7:55am-11:00am

All PreK-6 students report to their homerooms at 7:55am and will be dismissed at 11:00am. \*No After School Care provided. All Preschool and Kindergarten students will attend half days 7:55am-11:00am on Friday, August 26. Students in 1st through 6th grade will dismiss at 2:45pm starting Friday, August 26.

Upper School (7-12) - 12:00pm-2:45pm

All 7-12 grade students will report to House/Advisory at noon, participate in a welcome assembly, and then progress through their seven class periods. Dismissal will be at 2:45pm. They will report at 7:55am

for their first full day on Friday, August 26<sup>th</sup>.
