APPLICATION FOR EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS (Free/Reduced Meals)

Please complete an application if you think you may qualify. The school receives other financial benefits, such as scholarships grants based on the data submitted. The federal pandemic relief for 2021/22 has been discontinued. To receive Free/Reduced meals you must complete an application for 2022-23.

The Minnesota Department of Education provides an application process for Free & Reduced Meals. If your family qualifies for free/reduced meals, you will only need to prepay for additional entrées or milk. Families that qualify for reduced meals will also receive meals at no cost this year. The cost of an extra entrée is \$1.80 and extra milk is \$0.35. Applications are included in this mailing and are available on the Parents page of the website – look for Hot Lunch under Parent Resources. If you plan to apply, please understand that if you qualify, it is not retroactive. If you have not applied yet, please contact the Business Office. Based on the number of qualified applicants, the school receives funding for textbooks and other education grants, even if you don't eat the free/reduced meals. To reduce paperwork and take advantage of digital signing technology, the following forms are to be completed online via Permission Click. If completing the form online is not feasible for your family, please contact the Main Office at 651-925-8700, and we will assist you with paper versions.

1) NONPUBLIC AID - TEXTBOOKS, NURSING, COUNSELING (Required)

Each year we ask parents to sign a nonpublic education fund form. This form enables Saint Agnes to receive services and funding for our school from the State of Minnesota. The materials and amount of services that we receive are in no way contrary to our Catholic mission. The funding comes from a portion of your taxes paid to the state. It is extremely important for you to complete this form so that Saint Agnes School can receive maximum financial support from the state. Our estimated total amount for services and funding for the 2022-23 school year is approximately \$250,000, but parents must complete this form to request the services/funds.

2) HEALTH UPDATE/PERMISSION SLIP INFORMATION (Required)

Previously, we have asked for an annual health update for students on a paper form from St. Paul Public Schools. We have combined the essential information from this form with the necessary medical and emergency contact information from our permission slip form for field trips. Completing this form eliminates the need to continually supply this information on permission slips. Rather, you will be able to simply acknowledge permission for your student to participate in the field trip and confirm that the previously supplied medical and emergency contact information is still current. 3) STUDENT/PARENT HANDBOOK AGREEMENT (Required)

1) TRANSPORTATION REIMBURSEMENT

Many families who commute from outside the cities of St. Paul and Minneapolis are eligible to receive transportation reimbursement monies from their local public school district. As reimbursements arrive from various districts during the summer months, the Business Office will either apply these to current tuition and fee balances, sending appropriate communication to families, or will forward the reimbursement check directly to the respective families.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ACADEMIC ONLINE PORTAL

Educate is our online academic portal for families. Educate is a secure website that houses academic records for all Saint Agnes School students (K-12). Parents and students can log onto Educate to review grades, homework, report cards and other information on classes at https://educate.tads.com/. New families will receive information by email in August on how to access Educate.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE FEES

We offer After School Care supervision to students in grades K-6 from dismissal (3:00 PM) until 5:00 PM each school day. This program, located in our school cafeteria, offers Saint Agnes families supervision of their student's self-directed use of time within a monitored space, a school supply of games, art activities, access to our courtyard playground (weather permitting), and an opportunity to complete homework. Students in grades K-6 remaining in After School Care beyond 3:15 pm will receive a snack at no charge. In addition, there are days in which a faculty member is available for tutoring within the program free of charge. Use of After School Care is monitored by a sign-in/sign-out system using a cloud-based application accessed via laptop. How it Works/Fees: Any K-6 student not picked up immediately after school must go to the After School Care area until a parent arrives. K-6 students that have not been picked up by 3:05 PM — except for those students involved in afterschool sports and other pre-approved activities - will be charged a fee of \$0.10 per minute per student between 3:05 PM and 5:00 PM; this is a base rate of \$6.00 per hour per student. Students not picked by 5:00 PM will be assessed a late pick up charge of \$10.00; students who still have not been picked up by 5:30 PM will be assessed a larger penalty of \$20; recurring incidences of late pick-up may result in a withdrawal from the program. Based on the actual minutes logged in After School Care from the sign-in/sign-out system, a monthly bill will be added to each family's TADS account on the 15th of each month. Please budget accordingly if you have multiple students in the After School Care Program. NOTE: Any family experiencing financial hardship and needing assistance with covering the After School Care expense should contact our Business Administrator, Bob Collett, at bcollett@saintagnesschool.org. There is no cost to any 7-12 grade students who are onsite after dismissal.

DUAL-ENROLLMENT REGISTRATION DATES 2022-23

We are happy to host our Dual-Enrollment option once again for some high school courses through the University of Mary! We continue to have 20+ courses available for 3.00 credits. The fee will remain \$95 per course (3.00 credits) as last year. To avoid confusion about registration dates, we've decided to publish them now for the sake of clarity. FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENTS

Saint Agnes has a \$100 fundraising fee for each student with a \$300 maximum per family. Students are asked to participate in the school-wide Annual Car Raffle to meet this obligation. We are delighted that a new automobile has been donated to the school for the purposes of this raffle. Sale of raffle tickets begins in November of 2022 and concludes at our Red & White Dinner on February 11, 2023. Students will be receiving details about the raffle in the fall; additional prizes and incentives will also be awarded to top student sellers. If a family chooses not to participate, or does not meet the \$100 per student goal, a respective fee per student will be added to their tuition account.

IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

Minnesota law requires that every student who is enrolled in school have up-to-date immunization records on file. Unless there are medical, conscientious, or legal exemptions, children are to be immunized against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis B, and chicken pox. *Parents: Please note that various boosters are due in Kindergarten and the 7th grade year.* Please check with your care providers for more information. K-6 HOMEROOMS/7-12 CLASS SCHEDULES

Your son/daughter's class assignments for the school year, including K-6 homeroom teachers, will be available online through your Educate account by Thursday, August 18. Every effort was made to accommodate Upper School student course requests made in the spring. Course selections will be adjusted due to schedule conflicts and academic needs only, and all must be accompanied by written parent permission. A \$50 fee per course change will be charged for any voluntary schedule change requests; there is no guarantee that approved requests can be accommodated. No changes will be granted after the end of the first week of school. If, after August 18, you are unable to access your schedule or have questions regarding Educate, please contact either Mr. Michael Adkins, Lower School Director, at 651-925-8756 or Mr. Karl Hendrickson, Assistant Headmaster, at 651-925-8755. Upper School locker assignments and combinations will be visible on student schedules on the first day of school.

MASS SCHEDULE

During a typical week, there will be two Masses for school students.

Thursday, 8:25 AM – Lower School (Grades K-6)

Thursday, 9:30 AM – Upper School (Grades 7-12)

On occasion, Mass times will be adjusted for various liturgical celebrations. Daily Mass at the Church of Saint Agnes is offered each weekday morning at 6:30 AM, First Fridays at 5:15 PM, and the long-standing Ordinary Form Latin Sung Mass on Saturday mornings at 8:00 AM continues as normal.

PICK-UP & DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

During times of heavy traffic (e.g. morning drop off and afternoon pickup), we ask families to please follow a set of procedures to keep traffic flowing smoothly and pedestrians safe. PRESCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN FIRST DAYS

Preschool and Kindergarten will dismiss at 11:00 AM for the first two days of school, Thursday, August 25 and Friday, August 26. This early dismissal helps to ease the transition to full days of school for our newest Aggies.

REQUIRED PHY-ED UNIFORMS

Grades 5-12 will be wearing a Saint Agnes Physical Education uniform. The uniform is \$10.00 for the shirt and \$10.00 for the shorts. These may be purchased from the Phy-Ed Department during the first week of school in August.

- You will receive automated notices from the VIRTUS system when requirements are due.
- You must maintain a current email address in your VIRTUS account to receive notifications.
- Complete requirements promptly.
- Overdue VIRTUS accounts will be made "inactive" and you will not be allowed to volunteer.

SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTOS

TUITION AGREEMENTS

All families should have received and accepted their tuition agreements for the 2022-23 school year; unless final details are being worked out with the Business Administrator. In the absence of a signed agreement, or an outstanding tuition balance from a previous year, students will be unable to begin classes on August 25. Payment arrangements for past due tuition must be in place by July 29 or students will be unenrolled for the 22-23 school year. Note: Per the policy contained on the TADS agreement pages, there is a 25% of tuition fee due for withdrawing a student after June 30. Please review the agreement(s) on the TADS pages carefully.
